Elizabeth House provides pregnant and parenting mothers faced with crisis and who might otherwise be homeless a safe, supportive home environment to raise their children. Women can stay while they are pregnant and up until their child's second birthday. Each resident is provided with her own furnished bedroom, access to shared amenities, weekly groceries, and staff support.

Elizabeth House is a non-denominational program, funded entirely by charitable donations including funds from the Knights of Columbus (KofC).
